THE HY CLAIMS

CHURCHILL & PERSHING COUNTIES, NEVADA, USA

WORK TO COMMENCE THIS FALL -- Acquired a 100% interest in 37 mineral claims with known occurrences of lithium bearing springs and clays in Churchill and Pershing Counties, Nevada. This work included 242 shallow auger holes to test the lithium dispersion below the feed source. Commercial analytical laboratories showed total lithium contents ranging from 86 to 1480 ppm from rock and soil samples in the auger holes.



THE LAGO PROJECT

WHITE GOLD DISTRICT, YUKON TERRITORY, CANADA



RESULTS EXPECTED SOON FROM RECENT GROUND WORK

-- Ashburton has established claims positioned adjacent to the White Gold discovery by Underworld Resources and directly to the North East of their Golden Saddle property. Published regional geologic mapping suggests that both claim areas are in metamorphic rocks similar in age and composition to those at the White Gold discovery. The rocks are

part of the Tintina Gold Belt that stretches through the Yukon Territory and Alaska and has produced millions of ounces of gold.

THE CHUKUNI PROJECT

CHUKUNI, RED LAKE, ONTARIO, CANADA

DRILL PROGRAM INTENDED THIS FALL

-- Recent geophysical work on the property defined a feature that parallels the major deformation and alteration zone hosting the Goldcorp Red Lake Mine and the Placer Dome Campbell Mine. This feature is crosscut by northeast trending faults also identified by geophysics. Rocks along the feature consist of mafic-intrusives bounded by granodiorites and mafic volcanics that are believed to be somewhat similar in composition to those hosting the Red Lake and Campbell mines.
